The Career Resource Centre also hosts the YES-Ghana Job Club which serves as a cooperative environment that offer support and encouragement to unemployed graduates, individuals seeking to improve their knowledge in the area of establishing their own businesses, and individuals who have not discovered their career potentials. The club is accessible to all and serves as a support group to provide self-help to its members.

The use of the Career Resource Centre is open to all youth of diverse backgrounds which include fresh graduates from all tertiary institutions within country, the unemployed and underemployed youth, young individuals with entrepreneurial minds and many more.

## Young people

- The Career Resource Centre is equipped with computers fully connected to the internet and is stocked with reading materials ranging from Business Management, Marketing, Public relations, Sales, Accounting and Finance, Motivational Books and many more; this makes available a wide range of information to young people.
- The Resource Centre provides one-on-one career guidance and counseling for young people. The Centre has counselors who are available to take young people through guidance on educational opportunities, career guidance, job search etc that enhances young people's chances of getting employed.
- The Career Resource Centre host an updated database of job vacancies and internship opportunities and a database of online resources relevant to youth development and career choices, including funding prospects.
- The Career Resource Centre hosts career development training programmes, workshops and seminars that provide support, develop skills, and aid in self-improvement for young people in Ghana.
