Objectives

During the implementation of this program/project many different objectives has been realized including:

Twelve Leadership trainers has been equipped and empowered with in 2 months

Eight Mentors has been trained and prepared for mentoring with in 45 days

Twelve Youth peer education trainers has been trained and equipped with in 2 months

One hundred forty four workshops have been conducted through out the whole country (from the cities to the villages) with in one year.

One thousand five hundred youngsters has been provided leadership trainings with in one year

One thousand five hundred youngsters have been provided Hiv/Aids awareness sessions, STD's education, and substance abuse and human rights trainings.

Forty Eight youth organizations has been mentored by providing organizational development trainings, developing organizational policies and procedures as well as trainings on report and proposal writing.

Forty two percent of the beneficiaries of the program were female
